Ex officio **procedure**, based on the complaint of Zoran Gavrilović, by email

Short description: Interview with Aleksandar Vučić

Report: The name of the broadcast is not specified in the complaint. An examination determined that the broadcast in question was Četvrtkom u 9, belonging to the news and current affairs programme genre, current affairs programme subgenre, specifically an interview with Aleksandar Vučić, President of the Republic.

The complaint refers to a violation of Article 62 of the Law on Electronic Media, as well as Article 16 of the **Rulebook on the Protection of Human Rights in the Area of Media Service Provision**.

Article 62 of the LEM relates to the obligations of media service providers in relation to the election campaign; since there was no election campaign in the given period, the complaint is meritless. Article 16 of the **Rulebook** relates to informing the public through the publication of results of public opinion polls; an examination of the relevant material did not find any content related to such polls, so there is also no basis for considering the complaint.

The allegations relating to the violation of Article 27 of the **Rulebook** (Hate speech) are unclear, neither the content that would represent hate speech nor the person or group that would be affected by such content is indicated. The complaint is, as a whole, incoherent and insufficiently clear.

Conclusion: The conditions for launching an examination procedure have not been met.
