**Subject:** Untimely complaint of the **Centre for Research, Transparency and Accountability (CRTA)**

Dear Sir,

The Regulatory Authority for Electronic Media received a complaint from the **Centre for Research, Transparency and Accountability (CRTA)** from Belgrade containing a notification about the content broadcast in the programme of the **Public Media Institution Radio Television of Serbia – RTS** on 6 February 2025. Since the complaint was sent on 10 March 2025, I believe that the 30-day legal deadline has expired: *the Law on Electronic Media (Consideration of complaints)*, Article 38, Paragraphs 1, 2 - *Natural and legal persons, including media service providers, shall be entitled to file complaints with the Regulator in relation to programme content of media service providers, if they believe that such content violates or jeopardises their personal interests or public interest, for the purpose of initiating an examination procedure against the media service provider.*

*The complaint referred to in paragraph 1 of this article may be filed within 30 days from the day of the first-run or repeat broadcasting of the disputed content.*
